Wolman® AG Preservative in Hallmark Certification

Wolman® AG preservative, a non-metallic solution applied by pressure-treatment, has been recognized for use within the Hallmark Certification of the Window and Door Manufacturers Association (WMDA). This is the preservative used to protect Wolmanized® L³ Outdoor® wood.

Tests showed that Wolman® AG preservative meets requirements of WDMA I.S.4, Industry Standard for Water-Repellent Preservative Treatment of Millwork, and is acceptable for use under the corresponding certification program.

According to Jeff Lowinski, vice president of technical services at WDMA, “A WDMA Hallmark is considered a mark of excellence among code officials, architects, contractors, and other specifiers. Obtaining certification requires in-plant inspection, testing of products, and periodic auditing by a third-party administrator. The Hallmark is referenced by government agencies and widely respected in the window and door industry.”

With this distinction, Wolman® AG can be used as part of certified windows, doors, or skylights produced by licensees of the program. The formulation, developed by Arch Treatment Technologies, Inc., Smyrna, GA, comprises three carbon-based ingredients that enable wood to resist damage from fungal decay and termites. In addition to its use in doors, windows, and millwork, the preservative effectively protects lumber used for decking, fence boards, and many backyard applications.
